Project Objective: The National Broadband Program (NMBBP) is now three years into a five year funding cycle from the National Telecommunications and Information Administration (NTIA). This initiative is mapping the availability of broadband technologies and identifying methods to extend adoption into areas having inadequate services.

Key Activities/Major Milestones

- NTIA approved changes with in-kind match sourcing.
- Two New Mexico Regional Broadband Implementation Plan Pilots have been selected: Northeast Economic Development Organization and Southwest NM Council of Governments.
- The Train the Trainer Program completed with positive results and lessons learned that included offering shorter classes in rural areas where staff resources are stretched.
- The DoIT NMBBP Portal website has many updates including a Training and Education area.

Key Activities for Next Quarter

- Mini-Strategic Broadband Plans for Telemedicine, Education, and Economic Development.
- Development of a Statewide Broadband Strategic Plan
- Collaborative Regional Broadband Implementation Planning Pilots
- Assessment of a new Broadband Portal.

Risks/Issues


- Reliance on telecom providers to accomplish project goals and objectives within established timelines.
- Stretched administrative resources to support the NMBBP.
- Development of public announcements describing the NMBBP.

Accomplishments

- The upload of Round Seven Broadband Data to the NTIA and update of the NMBBP Map is complete. Tools have been added to include a Provider Identifier and a "Speed Test".
- The Community Broadband Guide is online and hardcopies being distributed to each tribal entity, State Library, Strategic Planning Stakeholders, RBIP participants and many other requests.
- The Digital Literacy Resource web application, an inventory of institutions was completed and being assessed for public online access.

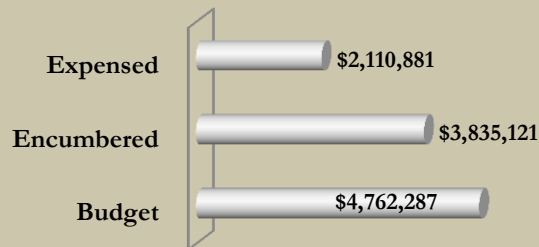


DoIT's Interactive Web Map  of Telecom Data, depicting:
